ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters, or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Rinsing application equipment over the treated area will help avoid run off to water bodies or drainage systems.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, hoes, and socks.

Do not spray plants suffering from drought (moisture stress). Do not apply during periods of prolonged high temperature combined with high relative humidity. Do not use this product with dimetholate, herbicides or fungicides such as Captan, Folpet, Dyrene, Karathene, Morestan or any product containing sulfur. Do not use with Sevin 50W formulation (carbaryl) on deciduous fruit trees. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Not to be applied to plants being grown for commercial use.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Shake the container vigorously prior to use.

- The best times to spray are early evening and early morning.
- Completely cover the target pest and plant with spray solution.
- Certain plants may be sensitive to oil. A small number of plants should be test sprayed prior to general spraying.
- Use caution on open blooms — bleaching and spotting have been observed on the open bloom of certain plants.
- May be used up to day of harvest.

Always test spray sensitive plants such as Cryptomeria, Smoke Tree, chamaecyparis, Juniper, Japanese Holly & Spruce. Do not spray Walnut foliage. Most effective on Whitefly during immature stages.

CAUTION: Up to 4 applications during the growing season are typically sufficient to control pests. Use a 2 week application interval. Do not spray when buds are fully open and elongation is occurring.

Azaleas, Begonia, Camellia Chrysanthemum, Oleffenbacfia, Easter Lily, Fern, Gardenia Geranium, Hibiscus Foliage, Jade Plant, New Guinea Impatiens, Palms, Philodendron, Poinsettia Portulaca, Reiger Begonia, Zinnias Dieffenbachia, Poinsettias,	Aphids / Fungus gnats / Leafminers / Mealybugs / Scales (soft & hard) / Spider mites / Thrips / Whiteflies* (immature)	Do not use on Coconut Palms or Maidenhair Fern. Chrysanthemum and Geranium Blooms have shown phytotoxicity at high rates.

FREQUENCY OF APPLICATION: For the greenhouse pests listed, use once a week initially. As the pest is controlled, decrease the frequency to 2-3 weeks as needed. Conduct a small scale test during bloom period to determine application safety for individual plant species.

Behind glass. Do not use on Coconut Palms, & Maidenhair Ferns. Chrysanthemum blooms have shown phytotoxic symptoms at higher usage.

Test for phytotoxicity by treating a few specimens before making a large scale application. Protect floor and floor coverings and furnishings from over spray.

CAUTION: Do not exceed 3 consecutive applications without allowing a 2-week interval without application.
